Reading – We read entire series of Harry Potter together this year and we listen to audio books while we run errands. John Doe chooses all his own books. Currently he is very interested in sharks, so we went to the library last week to find shark books.

Writing/Language arts – John Doe writes shopping lists for me, letters to his penpal, and is currently writing a story about a shark.

We also listen to audio books in the car, during quiet time in the afternoons, and sometimes before bed.
